

Rules for Swimming Pool Rentals

Persons eligible for use:

Anyone at least 21 years of age may enter into a lease agreement with the City of Madisonville for the use of the Madisonville City Park Swimming Pool. The City of Madisonville may deny use of the Swimming Pool to any group or any person who has previously violated a lease agreement with the City of Madisonville.

The selling of anything (admission charges, drinks, food, etc...) is PROHIBITED to the general public according to the City of Madisonville's Code of Ordinances. Non-Profit Organizations and Civic Organizations may sell for profit ONLY upon City Council approval.

Rental Periods:

There are two rental periods per day:

-5:30 PM – 7:30 PM

-6:00 PM – 8:00 PM

Rental Fees:

25 Swimmers or less: \$100.00

26 Swimmers or more: \$150.00

Inclement Weather:

In the event that your rental has to be cancelled due to severe weather or the threat of severe weather, 100% of the rental fee that was paid will be mailed to the address of the lease agreement. Refunds will be mailed within a timely manner. City of Madisonville policy will not allow the pool staff to give refunds from the pool cash register for any reason. Renter will be responsible for any and all damages during this time period regardless of cost. We will not endanger the life of any citizen or staff member due to inclement weather.

Reservations:

Reservations must be made at the Madisonville City Swimming Pool during operating hours and made no later than three days prior to the rental day. **All fees shall be paid at the time the contract is made.** Reservations are on a first come, first serve basis. No reservations will be made without a contract. The City of Madisonville will be responsible for having lifeguards present during the pool rental.

Responsibility of Lessee:

The person who signs the lease agreement (Lessee) shall be held responsible for any violations of the lease agreement or damages incurred. The Lessee shall be present at the Swimming Pool the entire time of the function covered by the lease agreement. There shall be no running, fighting, wrestling, or similar acts inside the pool fence. The Lessee is responsible for general clean up of all trash, etc. Lessee can bring their own concessions to a pool party; however, cannot sell any item (City Ordinance). Personal property can be left only with special permission of Park staff, but in no case will the City of Madisonville be responsible for safe keeping. The City of Madisonville is not responsible for the loss or damage of personal property or injury resulting from the violation of the lease agreement.

Alcohol Guidelines:

Alcohol is PROHIBITED on Park property. Violators will be turned in to the Madisonville Police Department. The Madisonville Police Department and/or Alcoholic Beverages Control Officer shall have the right to enter the leased premises at any time to ensure compliance with all applicable alcoholic beverages laws.

Cancellations:

- A 75% refund will be made for cancellations which are made fourteen days or more prior to the rental date.
- A 50% refund will be made until three days before the rental date.
- No rental fee refunds will be made less than three days prior to the rental date unless the party is cancelled due to inclement weather (see Inclement Weather above).
